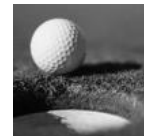

We all remember the tragedy that occurred on September 11, 2001 at the World Trade Center. This presentation will include a metallographic analysis of structural steel samples from buildings 7 and buildings 1 or 2. Sulfidation and copper liquid metal embrittlement will be discussed in order to form root cause theories as to why building 7 burned and buildings 1 and 2 collapsed.
